

Family Liaison/Social Worker

"Supporting the families of ill and injured Canadian Forces personnel and the families of the fallen."

The Family Liaison Officer is an MFRC social worker who is located within the Transition Centre, connecting both Centres to ensure that the widest variety of support is offered to families of CF personnel who are coping with an illness, injury or special need.

The Family Liaison Officer is available to help families cope with all phases of the CF member's recovery, rehabilitation and reintegration, whether he or she is returning to service or transitioning through the release process. Family Liaison Officers also provide tailored assistance to the families of the fallen, including professional counselling and referrals to appropriate civilian resources.

Family Liaison Officer services are free of charge, and are delivered by experienced professionals who understand the challenges of the CF lifestyle.

Deployment Support

The North Bay Military Family Resource Centre is here to provide support to Canadian Forces families experiencing separation while the member is required to spend time away from home for an extended period. This includes courses, taskings, IR and overseas deployments. Our services support families of Regular Force members, families of Reservists, and their extended families through the stages of pre-deployment, deployment, reunion, and reintegration.

- We offer pre-deployment education
- We help families to manage the challenges and circumstances associated with CF-related separation and reunion by offering support, raising awareness and empowering them to access relevant programs and services;
- We assist families to prepare for the challenges they may encounter before, during and after separation;
- We connect family members with each other, with other families and with the community;
- We offer support to families dealing with a crisis either before, during or after periods of separation.
- We provide regular monthly telephone support through our Warmline Calls.
- ROAD TO MENTAL READINESS (R2MR) TRAINING An educational deployment training offered to spouses one-on-one or in a group setting.

Veteran Family Program

The Veteran Family Program extends the traditional Military Family Services Program (MFSP) to medically releasing and released Veterans and their families, while also offering specialized transition programs and services. When a Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) member makes the transition from active service to veteran status, their family does too. Releasing from the CAF can be challenging for members and families, but even more so when the release is the result of a medical condition.

Enhanced information and referral services mean that we are here to help your family navigate the complex process of releasing, the challenges that may arise, and the sometimes unexpected impact on your social, emotional, and financial wellbeing. Our programs, services and approach are always family centered, strengths based, empowering and solution focused.

The partnerships that have been developed through the Veteran Family Program enable us to bring you standardized and effective programs that have been thoroughly evaluated and are well matched to addressing the factors for successful transition.

WASTE DISPOSAL

All members of 22 Wing are reminded that they are **NOT** to deposit any household or personal garbage, refuse, or other wastes into any Wing dumpster or garbage receptacle.

The City of North Bay provides weekly garbage pick-up and bi-weekly recycling pick-up, (blue box program).

Large appliances such as stoves, refrigerators, washers and dryers are items that cannot be placed at the curb due to their size and weight. If the appliance is still in good working order, it can be sold or sent to a second hand store. If the appliance is no longer working, there are a number of alternatives.

Household hazardous waste is found in every home and usually consists of common household chemical products that are hazardous if disposed of improperly. If you have items or are unsure of how to dispose of these products, the Hazardous Waste Depot is in operation from April to October, Wednesdays through Saturdays from 8 am to 6 pm at 112 Patton Rd.

Here are a few examples of hazardous waste that should be delivered to the Hazardous Waste Depot: Aerosol Cans, bleach, herbicides, pesticides, pool chemicals, antifreeze, cleaners, car and household batteries, paint, gasoline, oil, propane tanks and cylinders, solvents and fertilizers.

The Household Hazardous Waste Depot has expanded to include the following:

- Personal computers (including keyboards, mouse)
- Mini computers and components
- Mainframe computers and components
- Printers, scanners, drives and modems
- Instruments and controls (electronic thermostats, recorders, meters, etc.)
- Telephones (mobile, cellular and hardwire)
- · Electronic pagers and fax machines
- Electronic calculators, radio and stereo equipment
- Electronic games and video games consoles eg. Sega and Nintendo
- VCRs, DVDs
- Televisions
- Digital equipment
